Delegates and speakers are kindly requested to take the following dress code guidelines into consideration.

1. Working Subcommittees | Executive Committee General Assembly | Annual Meeting

Business Casual Dress Code

Men

Dress trousers or chino-style pants (no jeans), a button-down shirt (with or without a tie), and a blazer or sports coat.

Women

Dress trousers, a midi skirt, or an executive-style dress, paired with a formal blouse and comfortable footwear suitable for moving between event venues.

The InterContinental Hotel is fully equipped with air-conditioning systems in all meeting rooms. Attendees are encouraged to bring a blazer, jacket, or pashmina for added comfort.

Elegant cocktail attire.
